

# Associate of Science Degree Requirements (AS)

Requirements	Credits	Courses which satisfy requirements
Complete a minimum of 90 credits. All courses must be passed with a grade C- or better. These must include the following:

This requirement applies only to students graduating from high school in 1997 or later. This requirement may also be met by completing two years of the same foreign language at the high school level. This is not a requirement for earning the Associate of Arts degree.</li> <li>GPA admission, general education, and major requirements for the OUS schools are not necessarily satisfied with an AS degree.
